



Maejo University Announcement on
Appointing an Internal Quality Assessment Committee at Program Level

Maejo University has determined to have educational quality assurance under the criteria proposed by the Office of the Higher Education Commission in 3 levels, namely: program, faculty, and institute to develop indicators and criteria for internal quality assurance in all the 3 levels at the same time. In principle and practice for internal assurance at higher education in 2014, it stated that a higher education institution has the autonomy to choose a worldwide acceptable quality assurance system like AUN-QA system or EdPEX quality assurance criteria.
