

Maejo University Announcement on

Appointing an Internal Quality Assessment Committee at Program Level for the International Economics Program (IEP)
the Academic Year 2022

Maejo University has determined to have educational quality assurance under the criteria proposed by the Office of the Higher Education Commission in 3 levels, namely: program, faculty, and institute to develop indicators and criteria for internal quality assurance in all the 3 levels at the same time. In principle and practice for internal assurance at higher education in 2014, it stated that a higher education institution has the autonomy to choose a worldwide acceptable quality assurance system like AUN-QA system or EdPEx quality assurance criteria. The International Economics Program (IEP) would like to be evaluated its internal quality at the program level along with the criteria of AUN-QA in the Desktop Assessment Model in the year 2023.

- 3. To write a report and give suggestions for improving the quality of the program.
